PlayDay Information

- Please arrive 30 minutes earlier than your tee time.
- PlayDay tee times will be sent through email the day before each PlayDay.
- SGA Assistants will walk with groups to help with pace of play, rules & golf etiquette
- Parents are encouraged to support their Junior'(s) while playing with positivity & encouragement. We do ask parents to stay in their carts and leave the swing instruction to the instructors. Please feel free to help push the kids with pace of play, and walking quickly.
- Tee stations/tournaments will be based on skill & age
- Make-ups will be allowed if there's room in practice or PlayDays
- Weather Cancellations - If is more than 1 practice or PlayDay cancelled due to inclement weather, a Make-Up Session will take place at the end of the 7 week program.

Player Rules

- Appropriate dress includes khaki shorts, skirts, pants, collared shirts, belt, parkas
- Players must tuck in their shirts and wear a belt (girls do not)
- Attitude is everything
- Need to respect all parents, coaches, and players
- Laugh at bad shots, celebrate the good ones with a W.
- Take care of the golf course by replacing divots, using sand when available, fixing your ball mark on the greens and the one near you.

Parent Rules

- Parents/Grandparents are welcome to attend.
- If you rent a cart, the fee is \$15 paid to the pro shop.
- Please keep carts even with the players throughout each hole. Groups will be teeing off behind you, so we want to avoid any incoming shots. Encourage a quick pace of play. When the kids make it to each green, please pull your cart up even with the green.
- Rounds will take 1.5-2.5 hours. Some weekends will take less; however, for this first day, 2.5-3hrs is possible.
- Please bring **nothing but** positivity and encouragement
- Excessive feedback or telling them how to do things makes it difficult to play the game. It is ok to fail.
- Asking them questions is preferred so they can figure things out
- "I love watching you play," is the best thing you can say
- Please encourage every junior as they are trying their best
- Bad shots will happen as golf is the toughest game on Planet Earth
